Here’s an example: “**I**f you seek her as silver and search for her as for hidden treasures; **T**hen you will discern the fear of the Lord and discover the knowledge of God. **F**or the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.” (2:4-6, NASB)

An *If/Then/For* chart is included in this notebook. As you read, record appropriate verses and/or references on this Chart. *
